wo cutting-edge tractors liven up the agricultural scenery of WIKING in 2016: The Claas Arion 640 and the Fendt 1050 Vario. The construction site specialist of the Mercedes-Benz Arocs and the new Rosenbauer Panther 6x6 are also big winners with the power of functional details. The prototype of the newest fire extinguishing giant will be stationed at international airports in the coming years. The VW Touareg in police design does its sovereign honors. Anybody who would like to take a glance at the streets of the postwar decades will be thrilled to experience he fascination of WIKING. The Magirus round-hooded truck as street sprinkler in municipal services celebrates its premiere. With this, the tradition-rich model makers assign a task to the Magirus, which the truck was denied in the 1960s. The trailer rig of the Büssing 8000 appears just as authentic. It makes its debut as a flatbed truck with a superstructure in the design of the first two postwar decades. Joining the range of models are the Glas Goggomobil as a closed version with double bumper and the Citroën HY as a "SPAR" sales vehicle with shop counter that can be opened.

Sublime Setra brand advertising adorns the body flanks and recalls the over 50-year-old WIKING advertising model. Added to this is the finely detailed printing of the roof glazing. The Morris Mini Minor, the VW T1 Samba bus and the Mercedes-Benz L 319, which hits the road as a customer ser-

vices vehicle, are also debuting in the contemporary look of their prototypes. Memories of the automotive years of glory in Germany are also evoked by the BMW 1600 GT convertible, the Magirus TLF 16 round-hooded truck and the VW T2 in the first green-andwhite design of the police of North Rhine-Westphalia. The duo of the Mercedes-Benz Actros represents the logistical presence as a curtain tarpaulin semi-truck for John Deere and as a swap-body trailer in the Hansetrans colors. Moreover, the Mercedes-Benz G as a German Armed Forces military police vehicle is joining the model range. The Büssing 8000 pulls a log cargo into the world of N-gauge.

A s a "German Masterpiece," the Fendt 1050 Vario has gone down in Fendt history! Due to its imposing size alone, the side and front windows of the "x5 S" cab of the new Fendt 1050 Vario have been lowered for optimum lines of sight. The model is a winner – driver's seat and steps are foldable, driver's door and cab window can be opened. One highlight is the miniaturization of the engine hood, which is secured manually by belts. The variably-designed upper link of the rear hydraulics system is now extendable in its length. Again, the wheels of this precision model are removable.



This is the entry into the handy tractor range of Claas. WIKING miniaturizes the Arion 420, whose "Panoramic" cab has a transparent roof. The doors and rear windows can be opened. When the engine hood is open, the oil coolers can be tipped up individually as is normal for maintenance. In addition, the right-side ladder is arranged so it's movable. For off-road use, the chassis has a swing axle. The wheels with their magnetic hubcaps can be removed using the enclosed wrench and be put into maintenance position.



Practical suitability – the 1:32 model proves it. The Fendt Katana 85 with corn header and pickup makes all the details of the self-driving vehicle visible. The pre-compacting rollers are movable; the machine cover is designed to open all around. A look inside is made possible on both sides by the parallel movement of the panel sheets. Even the door to the cooler compartment, where the rotating cleaning unit is located, gives the model lover a remarkable invicible





NEW ITEMS APRIL 2016 WIKING ROAD-BUILDING SET



B eautiful classic vehicles to welcome the spring! It has finally arrived – the Henschel HS 14/16, making its debut as a long-awaited container semitruck. The Ford FK 1000 in the colors of the German Armed Forces with a new circle lamp as well as the Citroën HY, whose side shop counter can be opened, are further legendary classics from new and old molds. The Büssing 8000 pulls the Culemeyer low-loader, the DKW F 89 drives up for public duty in the fire department, and the VW Beetle 1200 is the "Yellow

Angel" of early ADAC times. The MAN flatbed truck appears in the colors of "Altonaer Wellpappe", and the Claas Arion 630 proves, thanks to its front loader, its cutting-edge loading prowess. A real treat for the eye is the first series presentation of the legendary WIKING road-building set – a play system once upon the time designed by WIKING founder Friedrich Peltzer so as to provide model fans with a true-to-scale road network. Moreover, fans of the N-gauge can delight over the Magirus tank semi-truck in "Gasolin" colors.



MODEL UPGRADES APRIL 2016 IN THE MOOD FOR CLASSICS



That's how 1:87 fans dream of the modelmaking springtime: With the WIKING model update, the stunning Glas 1700 GT convertible, which is reminiscent of the late production years of the Dingolfing-based Hans Glas GmbH, joins the model portfolio. Nonetheless, even the elegance of the model body that emerged from the Italian designer workshop of Frua could not prevent the takeover by BMW. The Unimog U411 is showcased in the traditional colors of the "Freyaldenhoven" shipping company. It pulls a trailer just like its prototype on the company grounds did once upon a time, linking it to a series of attractive WIKING classics appearing in contemporaneous shipping company outfitting. More classics include the Land Rover in the design of a service wagon of Ferguson, the VW T1 panel truck in "RWE" colors and the legendary Porsche 911 SC with Fuchs wheels. The WIKING trio makes the popular 1960s come alive geared to their prototypes – finely detailed printing makes it all possible. The Henschel HS 100 as a concrete mixer and the Citroën 2 CV Charleston whet the appetite for the modelmaking WIKING world. As the current official vehicle of the horse-mounted police squad, the tradition-rich modelmaker has miniaturized the VW T5 GP with the obligatory horse trailer – a rig whose prototypes are on the road in several German federal states. The Rosenbauer fire truck of the AT model series on the MAN TGM shows up fit for up-to-the-minute operations.

Utting-edge technology in 1:32 – for the first time, WIKING fits a combine with a fully functional caterpillar drive! The modelmakers have miniaturized the Claas Lexion 760 TT combine with the V 1200 cutting unit, impressive in both its width and design. The powerful 1:32 miniature has the functionality known from the Lexion 770, which makes this model just as unmistakable as its prototype. With the Claas Lexion 760 TT, WIKING has for the first time produced a combine in the 1:32 scale that can easily compete with the original in terms of functionality and attention to detail. The front-mounted, removable V 1200 high-performance cutting unit has a height-adjustable rotor with free-floating times and can be transported to the next field to be harvested by means of the vehicle for the cutting unit. Numerous true-to-prototype details, such as the engine and ventilation flaps that can be opened and the horizontally-rotatable straw chopper will enthrall viewers immediately. In addition, the elaborate opening mechanism of the grain tank – which can bunker up to 12,500 liters of grain in reality – makes the inside "floating" auger visible. In the 32-fold minia-

turization, which WIKING has created with its traditional demand for premium quality, the clarity and excellent all-round visibility of the comfortable cab of the prototype are as clear as day. Making discoveries is fun, because many more details such as different work lights and much more have been precisely replicated.

'IKING premiere for a new Claas combine generation: A modelmaking masterpiece with full functionality is making its debut: the Tucano 570 with front attachment for grain and cutting unit trolley. odelmaking perfection in 1:87 with the new E-Class from MB, WIKING places new highlights on details. Elements that fundamentally define the type such as the front headlights are inserted into the body with a minimum of clearance. Added to this is the trueto-prototype printing made possible by an elaborate chrome hot foil stamping process. What's particularly noteworthy: For the first time, the new wheels are designed by WIKING with the spokes of the rims effectively cut out. The all-terrain vehicle (ATV) for the fire service and the Still



forklift truck RX 70-30H in the service of the "Technisches Hilfwerk" are up-to-date and ready for daily use. But the new models include some that take a look back in history: For the first time, the Mercedes-Benz short-nose is used as a fire service water truck, while the "Frischdienst" Opel Blitz short-nose truck with a square hood drives up to deliver fresh produce. This is matched by the Audi 100, which has its premiere as a taxi cab, and the Magirus S 3500, which appears as a historic refrigerated box semi-trailer of the Wuppertalbased "Eylert" company. Now that the summer has come, WIKING has upgraded the Borgward B611 as a recreational vehicle. For the fans of the 1:32 scale, harvest time begins with the Claas Jaguar 860, which can be equipped alternately with the Orbis corn header and the pick-up. In order to upgrade this self-propelling vehicle even further, the attachable cutting unit trolley, the Claas Direct Disc 520, has been added.

eisure time feeling in the summer of 2016: The VW T1 as a recreational vehicle as well as the MB O 319, which the tradition-rich modelmakers have treated to a contemporaneous bi-color design, tell of traveling in decades past. The new mobile home (T@B) has completely succumbed to the retro feel – the egg shape of the years of the German "economic miracle" waves hello. Sporty and open, the Porsche 911 SC joins the program as a convertible. The race car design of the BMW 2002 in its orange "Jägermeister" outfit recalls the legendary races of the 1970s. In the meantime, the VW 181 was equipped as an ABC reconnaissance car in the disaster prevention services. The Chevrolet box semitrailer in the colors of "McLean" brings back wonderful memories of American highways of the 1960s. By contrast, the Magirus 235 D as a contemporaneous Schenker steel flatbed trailer is typically German. Friends of construction site vehicles have every reason to rejoice in the wheel loaders of Kramer and Liebherr, identical in color – a duo for major and minor tasks in the construction industry. In the N-gauge, Berlin's long-established shipping company Harry W. Hamacher will show its colors in the future – made possible by the MB L 2500 as a box truck.

IKING starts the harvest season with the brand new Claas Lexion 770 TT with the V 1050 grain cutter – an imposing machine with high precision standard. The functional Terra Trac has been miniaturized for the first time in the agricultural section - it stands for cross-country mobility of the latest harvester generation. The VW T5 GP California and the MAN TGX Euro 6 with the Meiller swap body in the colours of "Alba" show the everyday street life. For the first time, the Renault R4 is used as a French gendarmerie vehicle while the Morris Mini-Minor debuts as a right hand drive. Two new classic models appear - the Magirus S 3500 as a platform flatbed trailer loaded with basalt rock and the Krupp Titan as a flatbed truck of the "Royal Air Force". The Mercedes-Benz 1620 of the seventies with its cubic cab goes back to the "Mercedes-Benz-Service". Last but not least WIKING presents the VW Beetle 1200 in the colours of the "Berufsfeuerwehr Köln" going back to the longstanding services in the fire security.

The today's street life represent the attractive black-coloured Claas Axion 850 as well as the Krampe Halfpipe dumper in mint green - the colours of "Osters & Voß"for the construction sites. The "Dethleffs 530" caravan appears just in time as a late summer holiday enjoyment. N-scale fans can complete their fire engine collection with the Magirus DL turntable ladder.

oday's agriculture can hardly imagine a tractor as symbolic as the Fendt 939 Vario - a real field and farmland giant, now in the current Fendt colour Nature Green. However the model upgrading also allows the return of the legendary, first-generation VW Golf GTI. And in a very sophisticated dark blue metallic, at that! What Ford in Cologne and Borgward in Bremen got going in the "Wirtschaftswunder Deutschland", WIKING miniaturises with the Ford Taunus 12 M and the Borgward Isabella Sedan of course in contemporary design.
